“Funatic” Players Code of Conduct

- Play by the Old School Rules
- Don't argue or get angry – we're here to have fun
- Be a good sport – gain the respect of other players and referees
- Play for the love of the game and to improve your skills
- Don't make remarks based on gender, race or ability – it's not cool

“Funatic” Referees Code of Conduct

- Promote the Old School Rules
- Help players to have fun and build their confidence
- Remember the age of players - ref accordingly
- Treat others fairly – as you would like to be treated
- Show players how to act with respect – lead the way!

“Funatic” Spectators Code of Conduct

- Encourage participation – but never force it
- Remember it's not about winning or losing – it's how you play the game
- Build them up with cheering and encouragement – don't bring them down
- Don't publicly criticise refs – they're doing their best
- Don't make remarks based on gender, race or ability – set the right example
